Our Mission

The mission of the Reyburn Sailing School is to support a Learn-to-Sail and Learn-to-Race program that teaches students, both children and adults the basics of boat handling, seamanship, safety, sportsmanship, and building friendships. The program strives to develop competence and confidence in our sailors in a safe and fun learning environment.

Who Can Take Our Classes?

The program is open to EYC members' and nonmembers' children ages 6-17. Our Adult program is open to adults 18 and up. Registration is limited, and is on a first come basis. Priority will be given to EYC members and nonmembers that have been in our program in a previous session/year.

Our Boats

Optimist Dinghy

Designed for sailors weighing 50-110 lbs., the Optimist Dinghy has become the world standard for introductory junior trainers. Our Opti class is designed for our youngest students ages 6-13.

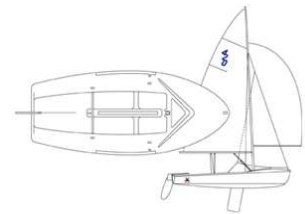
Club 420

These popular trainers are agile performers. These boats are great training boats especially in restricted sailing areas. Comfortable buoyancy tanks ensure that the CLUB 420 self rescuing and is safe. Our Club 420 classes are designed for children and adults ages 10-90. Adults will sail in groups of 2, while children will sail in groups of 2-3 per boat.

All our instructors are US SAILING Level 1, CPR, and First Aid certified. Some of our advanced instructors are US SAILING Level II certified. All come highly recommended with a great track record for hands-on instruction.

Junior Course Descriptions

Seaman (Beginner, ages 6-7, Student must be 6 by May 1st) This 6-week Evening Class that is geared for our youngest sailors with an emphasis placed on safety, learning, and fun! Students are introduced to water safety, boat controls (main sheet and tiller), basic sailing maneuvers (tacking and jibing), and wind, through classroom and on-the-water activities. Our goal is to create a positive learning environment so our little ones are excited to sail. Class size limited to 14. Note: Parents are encouraged to volunteer 2 evenings during the program to assist instructors.

Mate (Beginner and Intermediate, ages 8 -10, Student must be 8 by May 1st) This 8-week class is for our younger sailors who want to participate in our traditional all day program. Students sail independently in our Optimist dinghies under the close supervision of instructors and participate daily in classroom lessons and land-based activities. The curriculum emphasizes terminology, basic seamanship (knot tying, rigging), basic boat handling (steering, sail trim, capsize recovery) and course sailing. Class size limited to 14.

Club 420

8 Week Learn-to-Sail (Beginner and Intermediate, ages 10-16, Student must be 10 by May 1st) This 8-week class introduces sailors to the basics of sailing. The curriculum emphasizes terminology, wind and water theory, water safety, boat controls, sailing maneuvers, upwind and downwind sailing, and right-of-way rules through on land and on-the-water activities. As students progress curriculum emphasizes terminology, basic seamanship skills (knot tying, rigging), basic boat handling (steering, sail trim, capsize recovery), basic course sailing, introduction to the spinnaker, and beginner racing. Class size limited to 36, Friday class 30.

Students with a Skipper rating will be separated for advanced lessons.

For decades, the Erie Yacht Club has provided young sailors with the opportunity to participate in one of the most competitive racing programs on the Great Lakes. Acceptance into the program is based upon prior sailing experience and merit. **Sailors must have participated in the “420 Learn to Sail” program and have proven skills necessary to race. Our 2017 program will feature both travel and local racing opportunities.** Each venue will provide an exciting racing experience. This season we have developed a more extensive local racing protocol which will include awards as well as other incentives for those not participating in an out of town event.

Race Team Descriptions

Opti-Race Team

Optimist Race Team, ages 10-13:

The 8 week Opti racing program is designed to build upon the basic sailing and rudimentary racing skills learned in our **day classes**. **The focus of the Opti curriculum is to improve sailors' boat-handling skills and racing rules knowledge.** Throughout the summer our Opti sailors will learn about small boat racing, including tactics during a race. These sailors will be exposed to a strong team atmosphere in which sportsmanship is emphasized in all activities. The Opti team members are strongly encouraged to sail in the annual Eriegatta at the Erie Yacht Club and are also encouraged to travel to any I-LYA regattas that the team is participating in, should the coach deem them ready to race. Class size is limited to 10.

Local Race Team

420 Local Race Team, ages 13-18:

Sailors that have participated in the 420 "Learn to Sail" day program and have achieved the "skipper" rating are permitted to sail in the 9 week local race team program on the 420. The focus of this program is to build sailing knowledge in a progressive racing curriculum. All members of the local Reyrburn Race Team will have the opportunity to compete in weekly local races. Awards will be presented at the conclusion of each race week. The season will conclude with the winning team presented with a trophy and each a \$500.00 scholarship. Local Race Team sailors also have the opportunity to demonstrate their sailing skills to the coaches and to potentially qualify for the Travel Team. All Local Race Team members are encouraged to participate in the annual Eriegatta held at EYC in August of each year.

420 Local Race Team is limited to 20,

Travel Race Team

420/Laser Travel Race Team, ages 14-18:

Sailors must have raced on the Local Race Team and been recommended to participate in the Travel Race Team by their coaches. The 420 Travel Race team will practice during the week and travel on weekends. Formed in 1998, the I-LYA Junior Traveler Series is a summer-long series of regattas hosted by I-LYA member clubs throughout our region. The intent of the Traveler Series is to offer increased opportunities to sail and improve the competitiveness of our junior sailors throughout the I-LYA. One-day regattas are held weekly throughout the season. The summer race schedule will consist of no less than 8 regattas, each venue will provide an exciting and competitive racing experience. Included in the schedule is the Annual I-LYA Bay Week Regatta at Put-In-Bay, Ohio. Boats are provided for the sailors by our Club or the sailors own boat. Sailors interested in racing Lasers must provide their own boats. Parental chaperones and additional expenses for travel to regattas will apply.

420 Travel Race Team is limited to 12, Laser Class limited to 5.

Race Team Parent Responsibility & Orientation

Parent participation is required for your sailor to be a part of the Travel Race Team. That includes traveling and chaperoning at regattas.

Prior to the start of the season a mandatory parent orientation session to explain the details of the Race Program will take place. Sailors of parents who do not attend will not be permitted to participate in the Travel Race Program.

Adult Learn-to-Sail

Choose a full 8-week course or your choice of (2) 4 Week Classes. We focus on the theory of sailing, terminology, rigging and de-rigging, equipment storage and care, personal safety, knots, safety on the dock and on the water, points of sail, small boat handling, right-of-way rules, capsize and man overboard procedures, and much more. Classes are taught in the Club 420 and limited to 2 students per boat. Tuition fees include US SAILING textbook.

Release of Liability, Waiver of Claim, Assumption and Indemnification Agreement

By signing this document, you will waive certain legal rights, including the right to sue or claim compensation following an accident, injury or death. Please read carefully.

I acknowledge that, directly or indirectly, I am, or in the future will be, participating in activities (“Activities”) provided by, or at, the Erie Yacht Club (“EYC”). I understand that boating, sailing and related activities, including the use of docks and facilities, involve a certain degree of risk, including the possibility of death or injury to persons or property. I understand and acknowledge such risks, and hereby voluntarily assume these risks.

As lawful consideration for being permitted to participate in these Activities, I agree that I will not make a lawful **claim against, sue, attach the property of or prosecute the EYC or the EYC’s** principals, directors, members, officers, agents, employees, volunteers, heirs, assigns, successors, representatives or insurance carriers (“Releases”) for death, personal injury, property damage, or damage or harm of any kind that I may sustain as a result of my participation in the Activities. This agreement is intended to discharge in advance EYC and Releases from and against any and all liability to me, or anyone acting on my behalf or on behalf of any Estate, including but not limited to liability for negligent actions, arising out of or connected in any way with my participation in the Activities.

I shall indemnify and hold harmless EYC and Release against and all losses, damages, liabilities, deficiencies, claims, actions, judgments, settlements, interest, awards, penalties, fines, costs, or expenses of whatever kind, including attorney fees and the costs of enforcing any right to indemnification under this Agreement and the cost of pursuing any insurance providers, arising out of, or resulting from, any claim of a third party related to the Activities and arising from my conduct or actions. I hereby agree to pay EYC for loss or damage due to my own intentional act, negligence or carelessness.

I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to read and obey all posted information and warnings and to comply promptly with and verbal instructions provided to me by Release in connection with Activities. I agree that my failure to observe such rules may result in revocation of the right to participate in the Activities without further recourse. I further acknowledge that I will not be under the influence of alcohol or any illegal, prescription or over the counter drug while participating in the Activities. I also acknowledge that my participation in the Activities is contingent on my receiving, reviewing and agreeing to the registration materials, including but not limited to any medical release form.

From time to time, EYC takes videos or photographs of the activities that it provides and sponsors. I acknowledge and understand that photographs or videos may be taken of me while I am participating in the Activities. I hereby give permission to EYC and Release. To use my image for promotional and/or advertising purposes in any medium, without compensation to me.

I have carefully read this agreement and understand that it is a legal and binding contract that supersedes any other agreements or representations by or between parties, and that it is intended to provide a comprehensive release of EYC’s liability. I hereby further agree that this agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and that any legal dispute arising hereunder will be litigated in the courts of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. I accept the personal jurisdiction of the courts of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and I waive my right to a jury trial in connection with any such legal dispute. If my jury trial waiver is deemed unenforceable, then I agree that any dispute shall be resolved by common law arbitration. If any portion of this agreement is deemed unenforceable, the remainder shall be given full force and effect. I have signed this agreement of my own free will.
